Safety Instructions:

- Not suitable for children under 3 years due to choking hazard from small parts.
- Only use the ladder on a stable, level surface.
- Ensure that the ladder is correctly unfolded and secured to prevent accidents.
- Avoid overloading the ladder and observe the maximum weight.
- Keep the ladder dry and clean to minimise the risk of slipping.
- No more than one person on the ladder at a time.
- Do not use the ladder if it is visibly damaged.
- Always position your hands and feet on the ladder during use.
- Do not stand on the top rungs.
- Always keep your hand on the ladder when climbing up and down.
- Use spacers on the ladder feet to prevent fingers from being trapped.
- Do not carry long or heavy objects when using the ladder.
- Do not use the ladder as a means of transport.
- Check for damage before use.
- Do not use in adverse weather conditions.
- The folding mechanisms and joints should be in good condition.
- Always use two hands to stabilise yourself on the ladder.
- Keep children and pets away from the ladder.
- Pay attention to the surroundings and remove any obstacles or tripping hazards.
- Protect your fingers when folding and unfolding the ladder.
- Do not pull or push the ladder during use.
- Ensure a secure stand to prevent the appliance from tipping over.
- Read the safety instructions and operating instructions before use.
