Safety Instructions:

- Ladders must always be placed on a level and stable surface when in use.
- Check the ladder for visible damage or loose parts before use and do not use a damaged ladder.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of the ladder and do not overload the rungs.
- Do not use the ladder alone and secure it against tipping or falling over before use.
- The ladder may only be used by a person who is familiar with its use.
- Do not use the ladder near electrical cables to avoid electric shocks.
- The ladder should not be used in poor weather conditions or on wet surfaces.
- Children are not permitted to use the ladder. Keep children away during use.
- Personal protective equipment, such as a helmet and suitable shoes, is recommended when working at height.
- Read and follow the enclosed instructions for safe use and assembly of the ladder.
- Do not use the ladder in strong winds or if the balance could be affected.
- Ensure that the sliding parts are fully engaged and that the sliding part lock, if available, is used.
- Do not use the ladder as a single ladder if it is not intended for this purpose.
- Check the non-slip ladder feet regularly for damage.
- Ensure that the ladder is held by a second person when it is used in a steep or high position.
- Prevent tools or other objects from falling.
- Do not hang the ladder on moving parts or sharp edges.
