Safety Instructions:

- Risk of suffocation due to improper handling of the ladder height.
- Risk of falling if used incorrectly.
- Only use on a firm, level, stable floor to prevent unintentional tipping over.
- Always keep a safe distance from electrical cables and do not use the ladder near electricity or during thunderstorms to avoid the risk of electric shock.
- Avoid using the ladder in unfavourable weather conditions, such as strong winds or wet conditions.
- Always pay attention to the maximum load capacity and do not exceed it in order to minimise safety risks.
- Before use, check the ladder and all rungs for damage and stability to ensure their safety.
- Keep the rungs free of moisture, dirt, oil or other slippery substances to prevent slipping.
- Check the ladder regularly for damage and do not use if there are any defects.
- The ladder should only be used by one person at a time. Children may only use the ladder under the supervision of an adult or should not use it at all.
- The ladder is not suitable for use as scaffolding or a work platform.
- After use, store the ladder safely in a dry and protected area.
- When climbing the ladder, always ensure a safe posture and free hands. If possible, enlist the help of a partner for stability.
- Ensure that the ladder is always in an upright position and avoid hopping or jumping on the ladder.
- Read the safety instructions carefully and follow them before using the ladder.
- Do not use unsafe, makeshift supports or bases.
- Ensure training in the use of the ladder; do not use if unsafe to do so.
- Always keep an eye on the centre of the rungs when climbing up and down to ensure safety.
- Ensure that the ladder is suitable for its intended use and avoid using it on slippery or uneven surfaces.
- The ladder should be checked at least once in a while by a specialist for safety and condition.
