Safety Instructions:

- Before use, ensure that the ladder is stable and that the maximum load capacity of 150 kg is not exceeded.
- Do not work in the vicinity of electrical cables to avoid the risk of electric shock.
- The ladder should not be used without the support of a second person to minimise the risk of falling.
- Check the steps for damage before use. Damaged steps must not be used.
- Follow the instructions for safe installation and use of the ladder to avoid accidents.
- The ladder must be set up on a stable, non-slip surface or level and stable ground to ensure safety.
- Do not use on an unstable or sloping surface.
- In poor weather conditions (rain, snow, etc.) or wet conditions, use is not recommended as there is a risk of slipping.
- Choking hazard: Keep children away from the ladder.
- Only use the ladder when you are safely standing on the steps and keep both hands free for a secure hold.
- Ladder can be climbed on both sides, but cannot be used as a work platform.
- Do not use when tired or under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Keep the rungs dry and free of dirt for a secure stand.
- Check the ladder regularly for damage or signs of wear.
- Do not use in extreme temperature conditions that could damage conductors.
- When working at height, ensure that the health and safety of the user is not jeopardised.
- Ensure secure footing with non-slip foot caps.
- Avoidance of overloading when several people climb on.
- Follow the instructions for safe use and maintenance.
- Only to be used by persons who are familiar with the safe use of ladders.
- Suitable for applications at heights up to max. 3050 mm.
