Safety Instructions:

- Only use the ladder on a stable, level surface.
- Always secure the ladder with the safety belts provided to prevent it from sliding apart unintentionally.
- Ensure that nobody is standing under or near the ladder while you are working.
- Wear suitable shoes with non-slip soles when using the ladder.
- Check all parts of the ladder for damage or defects before use.
- Do not leave the ladder unattended, especially in the vicinity of children.
- Observe the specified maximum working heights.
- Do not exceed the maximum working height.
- Always lean the ladder against a fixed object.
- Avoid use in windy and unfavourable weather conditions.
- No more than one person on the ladder at a time.
- Regularly check seat belts and non-slip foot plugs for wear.
- Do not use the ladder if it is damaged or deformed.
- Always hold the ladder at an appropriate angle to ensure stability.
- Avoid using the ladder in the vicinity of electrical cables.
- Use the safety instructions for proper use of the ladder.
- Avoid folding or sliding the ladder apart during use.
- Do not overload the ladder beyond the specified weight capacity.
- Risk of falling if the ladder is used incorrectly or overloaded.
- Keep children away from the ladder.
- Before use, check that all screws and connections are tight.
- Consider not using the ladder in windy or bad weather conditions.
