Safety Instructions:

- The rolling plate may only be used by one person to avoid injuries caused by overloading or uncontrolled rolling.
- Ensure that the load capacity of the roller plate of 1000 kg, 1500 kg, 2000 kg or 3000 kg is not exceeded in order to avoid structural damage or injury. Observe the maximum load capacity (1500 kg).
- Before use, always check that the wheels and ball bearings are in perfect condition and regularly monitor them for wear or damage to prevent accidents caused by material failure.
- The roller plate must not be used on uneven surfaces, on slopes or near public transport routes, as this increases the risk of tipping over.
- Wear protective gloves and safety goggles to avoid injury from sharp edges or drill holes when handling the plate and to take appropriate protective measures.
- Secure the load to prevent it from slipping or falling during transport and ensure that the cargo bed is correctly mounted and anchored.
- Ensure that there are no persons in the danger zone when the castor plate is in motion and remove fingers and hands from the loading surface when it is in motion.
- Read and follow the operating instructions carefully and follow the instructions for safe use and maintenance of the roller plate to avoid overloading and accidents.
- The castor plate should be used on firm, stable surfaces and elevation should be avoided to prevent it from tipping over.
