Safety Instructions:

- Risk of suffocation due to improper handling of small parts when adjusting the height.
- Risk of electric shock due to improper earthing or damage to the safety resistor.
- Risk of injury due to improper use of the height adjustment.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of 150 kg to avoid the risk of injury due to unstable table construction.
- Adjust the height of the extension table between 650 mm and 900 mm.
- Observe ESD protection measures to prevent electrostatic discharge.
- Use a safety resistor of 1 MΩ for earthing.
- Avoid moisture to prevent damage to electrical components.
- Ensure earthing by regularly checking the table for conformity with the electrical requirements.
- The product must be placed in a stable position to prevent it from tipping over.
- Only use the tools provided to adjust the height.
- Before use, ensure that all screws are firmly tightened.
- Carry out earthing in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- Ensure that the table is only used by trained personnel in electrostatic environments.
