Safety Instructions:

- Safe assembly: Sliding door wardrobe can tip over. Follow the assembly instructions carefully to ensure safety.
- Sharp Edges Warning: Sharp edges and corners due to improper handling during assembly and use, caution is advised.
- Regular inspection: Parts should be checked regularly for looseness to ensure stability.
- Combine Safety: Set up safely, check regularly and avoid overloading to ensure stability.
- Child protection: Children should not play unsupervised near the product to avoid injury.
- Secure placement: Place the product on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Lock use: Use the lock for secure storage of sensitive documents, but it is not childproof.
- Not suitable for storing hazardous substances: The cabinet is not suitable for storing hazardous or flammable substances.
- Fire protection: Keep the cabinet and its contents away from sources of fire to minimise fire safety risks.
- Risk of overloading: Avoid storing heavy or disproportionate objects to prevent them from tipping over.
- Auxiliary assembly: At least two people should help with assembly to avoid injuries.
- Risk of crushing fingers: Be aware of the risk of crushing fingers when opening the sliding doors.
- Do not overload the cupboard: Do not overload shelves to prevent them from breaking.
- Location Precaution: Keep the cabinet away from moisture and extreme temperatures to prevent material damage.
- Stacking stability: Ensure the stability of stacked units to prevent tipping.
