Safety Instructions:

- Take care when using small parts to avoid the risk of choking. Not suitable for children under 3 years of age.
- The maximum load capacity of the shelves is approx. 50 kg; avoid overloading.
- Check and adjust the height adjustment screws in the plinth area regularly to ensure stability.
- Ensure safe use of the cabinet to avoid injuries caused by improper use of the sliding doors.
- The cabinet must be placed on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Avoid contact with moisture or water to prevent material damage.
- Provide user instructions and safety information in understandable language.
- During assembly, ensure that all parts are correctly fastened to guarantee stability and safety.
- Keep the doors and blinds closed during use to avoid injury.
- Children should only use the cupboard under supervision to prevent possible dangers.
- Do not allow children direct access and keep heavy objects out of the reach of children.
- The cabinet must not be used as a climbing aid or ladder.
- Secure the cabinet to prevent it from tipping over when heavy objects are stored.
- Ensure that all parts of the cabinet are securely mounted to prevent them from falling over.
- Do not exceed the load capacity of the shelves of 50 kg in order to avoid damage.
- Read and follow the installation instructions carefully before use.
- If the goods are defective, stop using the product immediately and contact the supplier.
- Regularly check that the door and drawer mechanisms are working properly to prevent jamming and damage.
- If the cabinet is mounted on a wall, use wall anchors to ensure additional safety.
- Make sure that no sharp objects can damage the blind or melamine-coated surfaces.
