Safety Instructions:

- Make sure that the back panel is installed correctly to ensure stability.
- To avoid injury, do not use sharp objects on the edge of the shelf.
- Keep the shelf away from moisture and direct heat sources to protect the materials.
- The shelf should be placed on a stable base to prevent it from tipping over.
- Take care not to overload the shelf when transporting it to avoid damage.
- The product is only suitable for use in dry indoor areas and should be protected from moisture.
- Suitable mounting materials are required for safe installation and the shelf should be fixed to the wall to prevent it from falling over.
- Watch out for sharp edges and corners that could cause injury; protect yourself during assembly.
- The product should be protected from direct sunlight.
- Suitable for storage and use by adults, not suitable for children.
- Manufactured from melamine-coated chipboard that complies with emission class E1.
- Regularly check the stability of the shelving, especially under heavy loads.
- Avoid overloading the shelves to minimise structural and safety risks.
- Always proceed with caution when using sharp objects for assembly to avoid injury.
- The product must not be installed in a damp environment to prevent mould growth and material deterioration.
- Keep the shelf away from hot surfaces and direct sources of sunlight to prevent discolouration and material changes.
- Only use mild cleaning agents when cleaning so as not to damage the surfaces.
- Packaging and assembly instructions must be complete and clear.
- The product is not suitable for children under 3 years of age due to small parts that could pose a choking hazard.
- Follow the instructions carefully during installation to minimise safety risks.
- If the shelf is damaged, repair or replace it immediately to avoid injury.
- Ensure that installation is carried out in accordance with the instructions to avoid injury.
- The shelf may only be used for its intended purpose.
- Keep the product away from extreme temperatures.
- Carry out regular checks for damage or wear and tear to ensure safety.
