Safety Instructions:

- Check that doors and drawers are properly locked to prevent unauthorised access.
- Ensure that the cabinet is placed on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Check and maintain hinges and locks regularly to ensure that they function properly.
- Keep the cabinet away from heat sources, moisture and liquids to prevent damage to the materials.
- Observe the maximum permissible load for drawers, shelves and suspension files to avoid overloading and structural damage. Maximum load: 60 kg for suspension files.
- Keep drawers and doors closed when not in use to avoid injury.
- Read and follow the operating instructions and safety instructions carefully before use.
- Only use the product in the intended manner to avoid injury and damage.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the upper shelves and secure heavy objects in the lower compartments to ensure stability.
- If necessary, anchor cupboards to the floor or wall to prevent them from tipping over.
- Avoid using sharp or hard objects near the surfaces to prevent injury and damage.
- Keep small parts out of the reach of children to avoid the risk of choking.
- Avoid direct sunlight to prevent discolouration of the decor.
