Safety Instructions:

- The cabinet should be placed on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Heavy objects should be stored in the lower compartments to ensure stability and prevent tipping.
- Drawers, shelves and filing drawers should not be loaded beyond their maximum load of 60 kg in order to avoid breakage, tipping or falling over.
- Doors and drawers should be opened and closed gently to prevent injury or damage.
- Ensure regular maintenance of hinges, locks and locking mechanisms to ensure perfect functionality and avoid the risk of crushing.
- The cabinet should be protected from heat sources, moisture and direct sunlight to prevent material damage.
- Small parts should be kept out of the reach of children to avoid the risk of choking.
- Children should be kept away from the cabinet to prevent injury.
- The manufacturer's assembly instructions should be followed carefully to avoid the risk of falling or tipping over.
- Secure anchoring of the cupboard to the wall is recommended, especially in households with children or for cupboards over 1.5 metres high.
- The use of sharp objects on doors and surfaces should be avoided to prevent damage.
- The product should only be used for its intended purpose in order to minimise safety risks.
