### Safety Instructions:

- The filing cabinet should always be placed on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Take care not to overload the cabinet. The shelves can be loaded in accordance with DIN standards and their maximum permissible load should not be exceeded in order to ensure structural stability.
- Use the lock to prevent unauthorised access, especially when storing sensitive information. Regularly checking the functionality of the lock is recommended.
- Keep children away from the cabinet to avoid injury from climbing or falling over. A supervisor should always be present when children are using the appliance.
- Regularly check door and hinge settings and all fittings for functionality to minimise crushing hazards and other risks of injury.
- Keep the cabinet away from moisture, water sources and extreme temperatures to prevent material damage.
- Avoid sharp objects or chemicals in the vicinity of the furniture to prevent scratches and discolouration.
- The manufacturer's instructions should be followed carefully when installing the cabinet. Correct assembly is necessary to prevent tipping or functional impairments.
- The doors of the cabinet can be opened up to 270°. Ensure that there is sufficient space around the cabinet to prevent injury or damage.
- Avoid storing heavy objects on the top shelves to minimise the risk of them toppling over.
- The product is not suitable for children under 3 years of age, as small parts or sharp edges may pose a hazard.
- All safety instructions and the assembly instructions should be read carefully and followed before first use.
- Close all doors completely to avoid the risk of injury. Make sure that no objects are trapped when closing the doors.
