Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the special regulations (ADR, RID, IMDG Code, IATA-DGR) and all legal regulations for the shipment of dangerous goods are complied with.
- Packaging must be correctly labelled and inspected. The cartons must be properly labelled, including UN marking (e.g. 4G) to indicate the type of dangerous goods (X, Y, Z).
- Cardboard boxes are only suitable for the specified dangerous goods groups (type I, II, III) and should only be used for the dispatch of authorised dangerous goods groups.
- Wear suitable personal protective equipment (PPE) when handling and shipping hazardous goods.
- Before using the product, a suitable risk analysis must be carried out and all technical documentation and safety data sheets must be available to support safe use.
- Packaging may only be used for the intended shipment of dangerous goods and must comply with the technical guidelines (e.g. TRV 005 for composite packaging).
- Warnings and safety information are required to inform consumers of potential risks.
- Information about the manufacturer, including name, address and contact details, must be provided on the packaging or in an enclosed document.
- Dangerous goods cartons must be handled in accordance with safety requirements so as not to pose a risk to health and safety during normal use and to avoid direct exposure.
- Ensure that the cardboard boxes are properly closed to prevent leaks and ensure safe transport and storage conditions.
