Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the office chair is placed on a stable and level surface and correctly assembled to avoid the risk of falling.
- The office chair can bear loads of up to 120 kg. Overloading can lead to damage or injury.
- Ensure that the chair is not positioned near stairs or as an obstacle to passage and keep it away from sources of heat.
- The safety mechanism, including the safety lift, should be checked regularly for proper functioning to ensure safe use.
- When using the chair, ensure that the seat height, backrest and seat depth are set correctly to avoid back pain and injuries.
- Keep fingers away from moving parts to prevent crushing.
- Keep the upholstery clean by cleaning it according to the manufacturer's instructions to ensure the longevity of the product and hygienic conditions.
- Keep out of reach of children and not suitable for children under 12 years of age.
- Take regular breaks, especially when using for more than 8 hours, to prevent tension.
- Do not place any heavy or sharp objects on the chair to prevent material damage.
- Avoid fast, abrupt movements when adjusting the chair and check the functionality of all mechanical parts regularly.
