Collecting tray AW 1000-2

Safety Instructions:

- Do not fill the collection tray above 1000 litres to prevent overflowing and to avoid exceeding the maximum collection volume.
- Biocides should be used to avoid personal contact with hazardous liquids.
- Take care when handling flammable liquids; wear suitable protective equipment (e.g. gloves, safety goggles).
- Regularly check the structural integrity of the drip tray for corrosion, damage and leaks. Particularly important when used in outdoor areas.
- Protect drip trays from direct environmental influences to prevent damage to the coating.
- Use only for the storage of containers with flammable or water-polluting liquids, not suitable for other liquids or substances.
- Take care when handling heavy containers - risk of injury when lifting.
- In the event of malfunctions, the product must be taken out of operation immediately.
- Avoid contact with flammable liquids during use or when filling the IBC containers.
- Ensure that the drip tray is used in a well-ventilated area to prevent the accumulation of vapours.
- Store only in dry, non-flammable areas in accordance with the applicable safety guidelines for hazardous liquids.
- Use only by trained personnel.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment, including gloves and eye protection, when handling hazardous liquids.
- Product contains hazardous liquids, take appropriate protective measures.
- Warning: There is a risk of fire if used incorrectly; do not use near naked flames or sources of ignition.
- Important: Follow the instructions for proper handling and storage.
- In the event of leaks, take immediate action to contain them and call for professional help.
- Place the drip tray on a stable, level, load-bearing surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Only use IBC containers that are suitable for storage and comply with the applicable safety requirements.
- Dispose of in accordance with local regulations for hazardous waste.
