Safety Instructions:

- Wall mounting should only be carried out on stable walls to avoid the risk of falling.
- Ensure that there is no risk of injury when mounting at height.
- Avoid using sharp objects on the rear panel to prevent injury.
- The anti-reflective film does not provide protection against UV rays, make sure that the product is not exposed to direct sunlight.
- Caution: Edges can be sharp, avoid risk of injury.
- The product is not suitable for children under 3 years of age, choking hazard due to small parts.
- Careful installation required: Improper mounting can lead to injuries.
- Avoid direct sunlight: UV-resistant film, but materials can deform in excessive heat.
- Not suitable for children under 3 years of age as small parts can be swallowed.
- Ensure that the frame is securely mounted on the wall to avoid the risk of falling.
- Wear safety goggles if the frame requires drilling during assembly to avoid eye injuries.
- Make sure to mount the frame so that it is securely attached to the wall to minimise the risk of falling damage.
- Avoid placing the frame in direct sunlight to prevent overheating and possible material deformation.
- Make sure that small children cannot access the frame to avoid the risk of injury from falling over or breaking.
- The anti-reflective film should not be damaged or cleaned directly in order to guarantee its protective function.
- Follow all instructions for installation and use included with the product to ensure safe use.
- Take care not to install the frame near damp areas.
- Use suitable tools and installation materials to ensure safety during installation.
- Keep small parts and accessories away from children to avoid the risk of choking.
- The anti-reflective film protects against UV rays, but the frame should not be exposed to direct sunlight.
- Check the mounting connections regularly to ensure that the frame is securely fastened to the wall.
