

Product Safety Information

Aluminium transport trolley with lid and cylinder lock

Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the transport trolley is only used on firm and level surfaces to prevent it from tipping over.
- Lock cylinder locks correctly to prevent unauthorised access.
- Observe the maximum load capacity and do not exceed it to avoid injury or damage.
- Check castors and wheel locks regularly for visible wear and proper function and replace if necessary.
- Read the operating instructions and safety instructions carefully before using the product.
- Load goods securely and distribute them evenly to minimise the risk of tipping.
- Observe safety regulations in accordance with DIN EN 1757-3.
- There is a risk of injury if used incorrectly.
- Do not overload the transport trolley to avoid injury from tipping over.
- Activate the castor brakes when the trolley is not in use.
- Keep the trolley away from hot surfaces and sharp objects to prevent damage.
- Use under the guidance of qualified personnel is recommended.
- Keep children away from the transport trolley.
- Check all moving parts regularly for safe operation.
- Observe protection against overloading in accordance with the specified load capacity.
- Always carry heavy loads with both hands to minimise the risk of injury.
- Risk of suffocation due to improper use of the cylinder lock.
- Risk of injury due to improper lifting of the transport trolley.
- Prevents the risk of slipping when moving on different surfaces.
- Do not exceed the load capacity of the castors.
- The use of swivel castors with wheel locks is recommended to prevent unintentional rolling away.
- Use of strong and corrosion-resistant aluminium alloy in accordance with safety standards.
- When using polyamide rollers, follow the specific instructions for use.
