Safety Instructions:

- Not suitable for children under 3 years of age due to the risk of choking on small parts.
- Keep packaging and storage out of the reach of children.
- Improper use may result in crushing or injury.

- Store and transport safely to avoid possible damage.
- Do not load beyond the maximum stacking load of 2500 kg.
- When transporting with a pallet truck or forklift, ensure that the specified underride height is maintained.
- Do not bring into contact with sharp or pointed objects to avoid damage.
- Ensure that the product is used in accordance with the instructions in order to minimise risks.
- Observe suitable safety measures for the storage of substances hazardous to water.
- If the container is damaged or cracked, do not continue to use the product and dispose of it if necessary.
- Avoid direct contact with aggressive chemicals that can lead to corrosion.
- The use of the product requires suitable personal protective equipment, such as gloves and safety goggles.
- Take care when stacking to avoid overloading.
- Do not use beyond the maximum load capacity.
- Avoid direct sunlight to prevent material damage.
- Ensure that suitable equipment is used for transport.

- Check the product regularly for cracks or other damage.
- Make sure that the stacking container is placed on a stable surface to prevent it from tipping over.
