Safety Instructions:

- Take care when opening and closing the sliding doors: fingers can get trapped; avoid injuries.
- Acoustic material can trap dust and allergens, regular cleaning recommended.
- Do not treat surfaces with harsh or abrasive cleaning agents to avoid damage.
- Pay attention to sharp edges on sliding doors and aluminium top track.
- Sliding doors not suitable for hanging heavy objects due to the slim design.
- Ensure that the sliding doors move smoothly and silently; excessive pressure can damage the mechanism.
- Products made of melamine resin-coated chipboard are not waterproof.
- Place the cabinet on a stable and level surface to minimise the risk of tipping.
- Push cylinder lock can be blocked if used incorrectly; avoid excessive force.
- Supervise children when opening and closing the doors to avoid injury; do not use the product for children without supervision.
- Caution: Sliding doors guided invisibly, risk of injury when opening; do not use in the vicinity of children.
- Choking hazard due to small parts; pay attention to small parts in the construction and keep away from children.
- Mount all parts securely to prevent accidents and tipping over; it is essential to observe the safety instructions for assembly.
- Carry out assembly and use in accordance with the instructions to prevent hazards.
- Pay attention to uneven floors: Use levelling feet for stable installation.
- Handle sharp edges and corners of the cabinet carefully to avoid cuts.
- Avoid placing the weight of children or heavy objects on doors; place the cabinet on stable surfaces.
- Be careful with acoustic materials with regard to flammability and moisture.
- Inform the user about the operating instructions to ensure proper use.
