Safety Instructions:

- Not suitable for children under 3 years of age as it may contain small parts that pose a choking hazard.
- The product could fall over and cause injury if it is not mounted or used correctly. Ensure that the U-frame parker is stable and securely mounted.
- For safe use, clear instructions for mounting and fixing must be included. Mounting material is not included in the scope of delivery; ensure that the product is mounted correctly.
- There is a risk of slipping when using the product, so make sure that the surface is level and stable. Only use the product on level ground and in suitable areas.
- Regular inspection and maintenance are recommended to ensure safety and functionality.
- Ensure that the product is mounted stably. Ensure that the U-frame parker is placed on a stable, level surface.
- Avoid overloading the bike rack. Observe the weight capacity, especially with fully loaded bikes.
- Do not use the product in wet or unstable environments. Ensure that the product is not exposed to severe weather conditions (e.g. storms, hail).
- The product can cause dangerous situations if used improperly. Use the product at your own risk.
- Do not use for bikes with tyre widths over 55 mm. Observe the maximum tyre width (55 mm) and the distances (350 mm) between the wheels.
- The product does not have its own safety nets or devices for the bikes. Ensure that the bikes are positioned correctly and stably in the parking spaces to prevent them from tipping over.
- The U-shaped parker is not suitable for any other use. Only suitable for use with bicycles.
- Children should be supervised in the vicinity of the U-Parker to avoid accidents.
