Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the table is stable and securely mounted to prevent it from tipping over.
- Provide labelling with the instructions for correct assembly and use of the table and follow them carefully.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of 150 kg to avoid structural damage or injury.
- Only intended for use with Treston TP and TPH series tables to avoid safety risks.
- Only adjust the table height within the specified limits of 650 to 900 mm and lock it properly to ensure stability.
- Avoid the risk of short circuits when using electrical appliances.
- Stability may be impaired if installed on uneven ground - check the stability regularly.
- The table top is heavy, caution during assembly is important to avoid injury.
- Ensure that all fastenings are firmly tightened before first use.
- Do not use the table as a staircase or climbing frame.
- Check the scope of delivery carefully, especially the fastening material.
- Recommended assembly by specialised personnel to ensure the stability and safety of the extension table.
- When using chemical cleaning agents on the table top, follow the manufacturer's instructions.
- Do not use the table as a work surface if it is damaged.
- Carry out regular safety checks before use.
