Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that all connecting fittings are securely fitted to ensure stability.
- Avoid overloading the partition walls to prevent them from tipping over.
- Suitable safety precautions must be taken during installation to prevent injuries.
- Keep small parts and sharp edges away from children to avoid injury. Also take care to avoid sharp edges and corners.
- Only use the product as intended and follow the installation instructions.
- The partition wall is not suitable for outdoor use in order to avoid corrosion.
- Regularly check the stability of the partition wall and tighten the screws if necessary.
- Make sure that the partition is stable and securely positioned to prevent it from tipping over.
- Use the floor levelling screws to compensate for uneven floors and prevent unstable installation.
- Avoid overloading the partition walls with heavy objects to prevent structural damage.
- Make sure that no parts of the partition wall can be damaged during transport.
- Keep small parts away from children to avoid the risk of choking.
- Ensure the use of suitable levelling feet for linear partition walls.
- The glass panelling (ESG) could break if handled incorrectly; take care when handling.
- Information material on safe use must be provided with the product.
- Carry out regular checks on the stability and safety of the partition wall system.
- Caution: sharp edges on the aluminium frames can cause injuries.
- NOTE: Take care when handling glass fillings as there is a risk of breakage.
- The partition wall should be set up on a level surface to ensure stability.
