Safety Instructions:

- Make sure to test the upholstery fabric for compatibility with cleaning agents in an invisible area before cleaning, especially for the 'Point' fabric variant, which is not resistant to disinfectants.
- Maximum stacking load: 10 chairs. Check the stability when stacking and avoid tipping over by exceeding the limit.
- The chair is not suitable for children under the age of 12. Ensure that children are supervised during use to avoid injury.
- Keep the chair away from naked flames and hot surfaces as it is made of highly flammable materials.
- Choking hazard due to small parts. Make sure that children cannot put them in their mouths.
- Check the seat and backrest surface regularly for wear and tear to ensure comfort and safety.
- Regularly check the stability of the chair and ensure that all fastenings are secure.
- Avoid placing the chair on slippery or unstable surfaces to minimise the risk of falling and tipping over.
- Risk of ignition if the upholstery fabric is not cared for properly: Only use suitable cleaning agents.
- Do not use the chairs in extreme conditions that could affect the structural integrity.
- Safe storage of the chair when not in use to prevent damage.
- Make sure that the chair is stable on the floor to prevent it from tipping over.
- In the event of malfunctions or damage, stop using the appliance immediately and contact the manufacturer.
- Be careful with moving parts of the frame to avoid the risk of cutting and crushing.
- Note the weight of the chair to avoid overloading the carrying capacity during use.
- Protection through lumbar support when sitting to prevent back damage.
- Observe product safety: Safety may be impaired if there are signs of damage.
