Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the tool cabinet is stable and securely positioned.
- Avoid heavy lifting to prevent back injuries. Due to the weight of 25.182 kg, care must be taken when transporting the tool cabinet. It is recommended to lift in groups or to use suitable aids.
- Protect the tool cabinet from water and moisture. Keep the product away from moisture and extreme temperatures.
- Check the safety lock on the door regularly to prevent unauthorised access. The doors of the tool cabinet are fitted with a security lock. Please ensure that the lock is working properly to guarantee the safety of the materials stored inside.
- Store small parts safely to avoid the risk of suffocation. Smaller objects or tools should be stored safely to prevent them from falling or tripping.
- Pay attention to uneven surfaces when transporting with the mobile frame.
- The tool cabinet should only be used indoors to prevent corrosion and material damage.
- Make sure that no objects in the interior can fall down when opening the doors. Store heavy objects at the bottom and lighter objects at the top.
- The product is not intended for use by children. Please keep out of the reach of children. Families with children should ensure that children do not handle the product unsupervised.
- Only use the tool cabinet in accordance with its intended use. Do not overload the product or use it beyond the intended use. The internal parts must not be overloaded to avoid tipping over.
- Keep the cabinet closed when it is not in use to avoid injury.
- Observe safety precautions when using drawers and shelves to avoid injury.
- Include safety information and clear instructions on how to use the product safely.
- When using the appliance, watch out for sharp edges or parts that could potentially cause injury.
- Wear suitable protective equipment when assembling or disassembling the product.
- Regularly check the connections and stability of the product. In the event of damage or signs of wear, stop using the product and repair or replace it if necessary.
