

# Product Safety Information

## Scissor roller conveyors, track width 600 mm

### Safety Instructions:

- Risk of suffocation due to improper handling of small parts and heavy material.
- Caution: Risk of suffocation from small parts, especially if used incorrectly.
- Risk of crushing due to incorrect assembly or unsuitable load as well as improper handling or placement.
- Risk of slipping due to improper use or insufficient stability of the roller tracks.
- Risk of falling when moving the roller conveyor, ensure stability.
- Warning for use near power sources or improper electrical installations.
- Caution: Exclude hazards due to improper handling of electrical components.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity: 120 kg.
- Not suitable for children under 36 months.
- Ensure that the product is placed on a stable and level surface.
- When adjusting the height, ensure that the supports are securely and stably locked in place.
- Regularly check the stability and functionality of the supports as well as the condition of the rollers and supports to ensure stability and safety during operation.
- Avoid risk of injury through correct use and installation in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- Observe safety precautions to avoid injury during assembly and disassembly.
- When using the scissor roller tracks, make sure that no body parts can become trapped between moving parts.
- Note: Check the correct height setting (700 - 1100 mm) before use.
- Observe the maintenance instructions to ensure the long service life of the components.
- When using the castors, ensure that they are placed on a secure and non-slip surface to prevent the system from tipping over.
- Inform users about the correct handling and monitoring of the product during operation.
