Safety Instructions:

- Observe the maximum working height and do not use the ladder above the specified height.
- Set up the ladder on a stable, level and non-slip surface.
- Before climbing the ladder, ensure that the storage tray for tools is used correctly.
- Always have a firm grip when climbing the ladder.
- Use safety belts if the working height exceeds 3400 mm.
- Keep small children away while the ladder is in use.
- Do not overstretch or load too heavily to avoid the risk of tipping over.
- Use only for the intended purpose.
- Do not use the ladder in wet or slippery conditions.
- Always wear suitable protective equipment when working at great heights.
- The ladder must not be overloaded; observe the maximum load capacity.
- Only use the ladder if it is in good condition and undamaged.
- Do not use the ladder near power lines.
- Do not move the ladder while someone is on it.
- Always keep both hands free when working on the ladder.
- Check the ladder for damage or wear before each use.
- For working heights above 3400 mm, please use the safety belts.
- Carry out a safety check before use.
- Observe the maximum user weight.
- Ensure that the ladder is fully unfolded.
- Store tools safely to avoid the risk of falling.
- The ladder may only be used by one person at a time.
- Ensure that the ladder is correctly positioned and locked.
- Check all fittings and connections for safety before use.
- Do not use the stairs beyond the top step.
- Keep people away from under the work surface.
- For safe use, always place both feet on the steps.
