

Product Safety Information

Stacking tipper BSK 90, for traverse discharge

Please note the technical data of the products!

Safety Instructions:

- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of 2000 kg.
- When stacking the tippers, ensure that the support legs are positioned correctly to guarantee stability.
- The tippers may only be used for their intended purpose.
- When used outdoors, ensure that the tippers are protected from extreme weather conditions.
- Watch out for sharp edges and splinters during maintenance to avoid injury.
- The tippers should be checked regularly for damage to ensure safe use.
- Before use, ensure that the stacking tipper is standing on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Use suitable lifting and transport equipment to avoid injuries.
- Compliance with the manufacturer's safety and handling instructions is necessary.
- Keep children away from the product to avoid injury.
- Caution: Sharp edges on the pouring walls. Risk of injury!
- Carry out regular inspections to ensure that the stack tipper is in perfect condition.
- Due to the weight of 100 kg (painted) or 110 kg (galvanised), care should be taken when lifting.
- Ensure stackability only with a maximum of 4 support legs.
- Check the bulkhead and elements regularly for wear or damage.
- Wear appropriate protective equipment during use to avoid injury.
- Carry out a risk analysis before using the product.
- Ensure that the product is not overloaded to avoid safety risks.
- Provide safety information and instructions in understandable language.
- Not suitable for children under 3 years of age as small parts can be swallowed.
- Observe the safety instructions due to the load capacity of 2000 kg.
