Safety Instructions:

- During assembly, ensure that all screws and connections are firmly tightened to prevent tipping or collapse. Regular inspection of the screws is recommended.
- Observe the maximum surface load of 300 kg to avoid structural damage and hazards. Do not load the product above this load.
- Keep sharp objects away from the worktop to avoid scratches and injuries.
- The table top is smooth, be careful when handling to avoid cuts or injuries.
- Ensure that the installation is carried out in accordance with the enclosed instructions in order to fulfil the safety requirements.
- Wear personal protective equipment during use, especially in workshop or production environments, to avoid injury.
- To avoid injury, do not use the table as a ladder, play structure or climbing frame. Not recommended for use by children.
- Keep the table dry and avoid direct sunlight and moisture on the MDF board to prevent damage.
- Be careful when handling heavy parts during assembly to avoid injury. Call in a second person to assist with assembly.
- Place the product on a level surface to avoid instability. Recommend a non-slip base to avoid wobbling.
- Do not use the product near open flames or extreme temperatures to avoid damage.
- Suitable for use by adults, not for children without supervision. Not suitable for children under 3 years of age due to small parts.
- The product is not suitable for outdoor use to prevent rotting.
- Environmentally friendly powder coating, no harmful chemicals, avoids skin irritation.
- Ensure that all necessary parts are available before assembly (disassembled delivery). Suitable tools required for assembly.
