Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the waste bin is fireproof and do not throw any flammable materials into it or place it near naked flames or high temperatures.

- Product is made of galvanised sheet metal, not rustproof, therefore protect against corrosion.
- The powder coating can flake off if handled improperly, so do not use sharp objects.
- Observe fire safety; the product is fireproof but not fire-resistant.
- The weight of 20 kg can lead to injuries; request support when lifting.
- Do not overload; maximum capacity 120 litres according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Dispose of the waste collector in accordance with local waste disposal regulations.
- Take care when lifting the waste collector due to its weight of 20 kg.
- Avoid contact with sharp edges of the galvanised sheet metal during use.
