Safety Instructions:

- Caution: Do not open drawers at the same time to avoid the risk of tipping.
- Observe additional safety precautions for use on uneven floors to ensure stability.
- Do not exceed the maximum load of 80 kg per drawer.
- When using on uneven surfaces, adjust the floor levelling screws.
- Observe the appropriate installation and operating instructions for safe operation.
- Risk of suffocation due to improper use of the drawers due to small parts.
- Risk of injury from heavy drawers falling if they are not properly closed or opened.
- Risk of crushing when opening several drawers.
- Ensure that the drawers are not overloaded to prevent the cabinet from tipping over.
- Provide instructions for safe operation and correct closing of the drawers.
- The drawers should be checked regularly to ensure that the pull-out stop is working properly.
- Avoid using the drawer cabinet in areas with extreme temperature fluctuations or high humidity to prevent material damage.
- Keep the drawer cabinet free of unnecessary objects that could prevent the drawers from closing properly.
- Caution: Use the pull-out stop to prevent several drawers from opening at the same time.
- Due to the height of the cabinet, secure the cabinet to the wall to prevent it from falling over.
- Use drawer guides according to the instructions to ensure that drawers are safe and easy to use.
- Regularly maintain the pull-outs and hinges to ensure safe use.
- Children should not be left unattended near the cabinet.
