Safety Instructions:

- Beware of heavy objects: The maximum surface load of 1,000 kg must be observed to prevent the workbench from tipping or breaking. For substructure container and workbench leg: 1,000 kg, for 2 workbench legs: max. 750 kg.
- Do not overload drawers: The load capacity of the suspended drawers is 50 kg, that of the drawers 100 kg. Overloading can lead to damage.
- Child safety: The workbench is not suitable for children as it has no safety features for children. Children should be kept away from the workbench. Take protective measures against crushing hazards at the drawers and doors, especially when children are in the vicinity.
- Wear gloves: Gloves should be worn when assembling or moving the workbench to avoid cutting and crushing injuries.
- Assemble according to the instructions: The workbench must be assembled in accordance with the instructions supplied to ensure safety.
- Regular safety checks: Carry out regular checks of the workbench to ensure that it is in perfect condition.
- Use the central locking system: Ensure that the central locking system is activated to prevent unauthorised opening of the drawers.
- Make sure that the solid beech worktop is handled with care to avoid scratches or other damage.
- Please note the opening width of the doors (180°) and ensure that there is sufficient space for safe use.
- To avoid injury, do not lift or store heavy or awkward objects improperly.
