Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the maximum surface load of 1,000 kg is not exceeded, including the individual statement that the maximum surface load should not exceed 1,000 kg.
- Do not overload drawers; maximum load capacity per drawer is 100 kg.
- Check product safety when using the drawers with a maximum load capacity of 100 kg.
- Place the workbench on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over. The workbench should be stable and secure.
- Avoid crushing hazards when closing drawers and doors. Ensure that the locks are properly closed to minimise the risk of injury.
- Observe the warning notices, especially when handling heavy objects. Take safety precautions when using heavy objects.
- Keep loose objects away from the worktop to avoid injury.
- Regularly check the slip resistance of the oiled surface.
- Only use the workbench for its intended purpose and in accordance with the operating instructions.
- Check the functionality of the lock mechanisms and hinges regularly.
- Follow the instructions for safe use and maintenance of the workbench.
- Avoid the use of chemical cleaning agents that could damage the material of the workbench.
- Avoid contact with sharp objects to protect the finish of the solid beech surface.
- Open doors carefully to avoid injury, as the spring hinges may require additional care.
