## Shelf trough type RW/GR 2200-2, with grating

### Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the shelf tray is properly installed, assembled and stably positioned to prevent it from tipping over, slipping or collapsing.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of 1000 kg/sqm to avoid structural damage or accidents.
- Take care when loading and unloading: Ensure the stability of the shelf and take safety measures to prevent crushing.
- Regular maintenance and inspection of the shelf tray for signs of damage, wear or corrosion.
- Do not use the shelf tray as a means of transporting people.
- Observe warnings and regulations for handling and storing hazardous materials such as chemicals.
- Before use, ensure that the tray is suitable for the respective application, especially with regard to the collection volume of 1,000 litres.
- Provide users with clear instructions for safe handling and installation in understandable language.
- Protect shelving trays from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to prevent material damage.
- Avoid use in damp or corrosive environments unless the tray is designed for this.
- The shelf tray may only be used within the specified override height of 100 mm.
