Safety Instructions:

- Product contains small parts, choking hazard for children. The roller shutter cabinet is not suitable for children under 3 years of age.
- Assembly should be carried out by adults to minimise the risk of injury. Safety instructions for assembly: Only assemble in accordance with the instructions.
- The rounded edges are helpful in preventing injuries. Safety precautions when handling sharp edges during assembly.
- Use only in accordance with the enclosed instructions to minimise the risk of injury. Safe use: Use the product according to the instructions and do not expose it to weather-related influences.
- The product must not be installed near heat sources to avoid damage. Ensure that the cabinet is not installed near sources of water to avoid the risk of short circuits.
- Observe the maximum load-bearing capacity of the metal shelves to avoid tipping or damage.
- Before use, ensure that the roller shutter cabinet is stable and securely installed. Ensure correct installation to avoid risks due to wobbly constructions.
- Avoid exerting excessive pressure on the roller shutters to prevent damage. Due to the pressure of the roller shutters, there may be a risk of fingers getting caught.
- Regular inspection of parts for wear or damage is recommended.
- Dispose of the packaging carefully to protect children from choking hazards.
- Securely close the integrated handle opening with a lock to prevent unauthorised access. The lock and handle opening must be kept out of the reach of children to prevent possible injury.
- Take particular care when using in households with children, as misuse is possible. Protection against improper use of the product, especially when handling the lock.
