Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the roller shutter cabinet is placed on a stable and level surface.
- Keep a sufficient distance from the hinges when opening and closing the doors to avoid injury.
- Keep the roller shutter cabinet out of the reach of small children to prevent accidents.
- The instructions in the operating manual must be observed before use.
- Pay attention to the maximum load limits of the shelves.
- Ensure that the product is correctly assembled and stably positioned to prevent it from tipping over or slipping out.
- Avoid use in damp rooms to prevent mould growth and rotting of the material.
- Keep the integrated height adjusters and levelling feet in good condition to ensure stable use.
- Ensure that the product is checked regularly for damage or wear and tear to avoid safety risks.
- Keep sharp objects away from the surface to prevent scratches and damage to the melamine resin coating.
- Ensure that the product complies with the general safety requirement and that safety information is provided in an understandable language.
- The product must have a type, batch or serial number for identification.
- Ensure that the storage or transport conditions do not affect the safety of the product.
- Avoid supporting heavy objects over the top edge of the cupboard.
- To avoid crushing, the integrated height adjusters should be properly adjusted during installation.
- Read and follow all installation and operating instructions carefully.
- If the roller shutter cabinet is damaged, do not use it and contact the manufacturer.
