Safety Instructions:

- Avoid placing heavy objects on or near the sliding doors to prevent damage or safety risks.
- Be aware of the risk of suffocation from small parts or panelling.
- Ensure that children cannot play with the product unsupervised, especially near doors when they are open or closed.
- Caution: Sliding doors can jam when closing. Observe pinch protection.
- Contains risk factors due to the use of melamine-faced chipboard; ensure that no harmful vapours escape during use.
- Avoid using the cabinet in damp environments to prevent material damage.
- Only use the recommended cleaning agents so as not to damage the surfaces.
