Safety Instructions:

- When closing the sliding doors, ensure that no body parts are trapped; do not use excessive force when closing the doors to avoid damage.
- Ensure that the acoustic fronts are not damaged by sharp-edged objects.
- The furniture should be checked regularly for stability and safety to prevent it from tipping over; the product must be checked regularly for stable construction and secure connections.
- Ensure that the levelling feet are fitted correctly to avoid accidents on uneven floors; the cabinet should be installed on a stable and level surface.
- Use the product only for its intended purpose to minimise safety risks; use of the product in accordance with the instructions provided is necessary to ensure safety and functionality.
- The product is not suitable for use by children without supervision; if small parts that are not suitable for children are used, be aware of the risk of suffocation.
- Do not place the cabinet near heat sources to avoid material deformation.
- Follow all assembly steps exactly to ensure stability and safety; check the stability of the screws and connections regularly after assembly.
- Protect the edges and corners of the cabinet to prevent damage during transport.
- Ensure that the sliding doors are correctly installed to prevent injuries caused by improper operation; enclose safety instructions for handling the sliding doors.
- Avoid accumulation of heavy material on the shelves to prevent tipping or breaking; avoid overloading the cabinet to prevent tipping.
- Sharp edges must be observed during assembly and use in order to avoid injuries.
- Ensure that furniture is securely and stably mounted to prevent it from falling over.
- Note on proper cleaning and care of the acoustic material of the cabinet in order to maintain its functionality.
- Provide correct disposal instructions with regard to environmentally friendly practices.
