Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the hinges and moving parts do not pose a crushing hazard. Take care when closing the sliding doors to avoid crushing injuries.
- The product must not be installed near heat sources or in damp environments.
- Regularly check the stability and safety of the shelves, especially the height-adjustable shelves, taking into account the maximum load.
- Correct assembly in accordance with the instructions is essential to avoid safety risks. All parts and fastenings must be correctly fitted before use.
- Be aware of the possibility of sharp edges on damaged surfaces and cover them if necessary to prevent injuries.
- Ensure that the product is standing on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over. Anchor the cabinet securely to prevent it from tipping over.
- Observe the height and weight of the cupboard to minimise the risk of tipping, especially in households with children.
- The wardrobe should be checked regularly for damage, stability and the functionality of the sliding doors. Take particular care after moving or sudden movements.
- Sensitive surfaces should be used without sharp or heavy objects to avoid damage.
- Make sure that the height of the levelling feet is set correctly to ensure stability.
- The rear wall should be checked regularly for damage to ensure structural integrity.
- Suitable tools are required for installation to avoid injury. Seek additional help during installation.
- Keep the cabinet out of the reach of children to avoid injury. Cabinet not suitable for children under 3 years of age.
- Consider accessibility features for people with disabilities.
- Check that the push cylinder lock is working properly to prevent unintentional opening.
- Provide users with clear instructions on the safe handling and use of the cabinet.
