Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that mounted parts are firm and secure to avoid the risk of instability.
- To prevent damage or malfunctions, do not use the product in areas with high levels of noise or vibrations.
- Keep children and pets away from the cabinet to avoid injury, especially when opening the sliding doors.
- Regularly check the function of the push cylinder lock and the height-adjustable shelves for safe handling.
- Avoid overloading the shelves to minimise structural damage and the risk of injury. Avoid overloading beyond the recommended maximum load capacity.
- To avoid injury, the sliding doors must not be opened or closed with excessive force.
- Pull the lock carefully to avoid damaging it. Check locks regularly to ensure they are working properly and to prevent unauthorised access.
- Secure the cabinet against falling over, especially if it is high or unstable, by fastening it securely.
- To avoid injury, do not use sharp or pointed objects on the edges of the cabinet.
- Make sure that the levelling feet are properly adjusted to ensure stability and compensate for uneven floors.
- Read and follow the installation instructions carefully to ensure correct installation. Ensure correct user instructions and assembly.
- Set up out of reach of children to avoid dangers from playing, climbing or potential trapping hazards. Cabinet not suitable for children under 3 years of age due to choking hazard from small parts.
- In the event of damage or a recognisable risk of instability, take immediate action for repair or return.
- Due to its weight, the cabinet must be securely positioned to prevent it from tipping over and must stand on a stable and level surface.
- Keep away from heat sources to avoid the risk of fire and keep the cabinet away from direct heat and moisture to prevent material damage.
- Only use the cabinet for its intended purpose to avoid injury and damage.
- Regularly check the stability and functionality of the cabinet, especially the sliding doors.
