Safety Instructions:

- Make sure that the cabinet is standing on a stable and level surface to ensure stability and prevent it from tipping over. If necessary, adjust the levelling feet and check their stability regularly.
- Avoid stacking heavy objects on the top shelves to prevent them from tipping over. Observe the recommended maximum load of the shelves.
- Keep the cabinet away from sources of water to prevent damage to the chipboard and surface damage caused by moisture.
- Only use the cabinet in accordance with the intended use instructions and ensure that all parts are securely fitted to prevent injury.
- Avoid using sharp objects when handling sliding doors to prevent injuries. Make sure that no fingers or body parts get caught in the sliding doors.
- Make sure that the cabinet is childproof and cannot be accessed by children to minimise the risk of injury.
- Only use the shelves provided and ensure that they are securely locked in place.
- Inform customer service immediately in the event of faults or damage.
- The lock is only intended for the intended use and must not be used for any other purpose.
- Aluminium runner in the top shelf may have sharp edges; take care when handling.
- Provide and observe the installation and utilisation instructions for the enclosure.
- The sliding doors can cause serious crushing injuries, especially if children are in the vicinity.
