

Product Safety Information

Changing bench, tubular steel/wood, double, 1015/1500/2000 mm wide

Safety Instructions:

- Check the stability and integrity of the changing bench before use.
- Ensure that the changing bench is placed on a level and stable surface to prevent it from tipping or falling over.
- Ensure that there are no sharp edges or splinters on the seat and backrests.
- Keep the changing bench away from heat sources and damp areas to prevent damage to the wood.
- Follow the assembly instructions carefully to ensure a stable construction.
- The product should be kept out of the reach of children when not in use.
- Ensure that the product is stable during installation to prevent it from falling over and causing injury.
- Before use, ensure that the surface is level and stable.
- Regularly check the stability and clarity of the bench to prevent accidents.
- Beware of potential risk of injury from sharp edges or corners.
- Attach appropriate warnings for use by children to prevent improper use.
- The bench should only be used for its intended purpose and under the specified conditions.
- Caution: Risk of falling if the bench is inadequately secured.
- Sand down sharp edges before installation.
- Bench is only suitable for indoor use; do not use outdoors.
- Do not use without supervision for children under 14 years of age.
- Do not allow children to play unsupervised on the bench.
- Avoid exceeding the permissible load.
- Prevent collision with other persons or objects during use.
- Ensure that the parts are used correctly when assembling.
- Observe the recommended seat height (450 mm) and seat depth (330 mm) to ensure stability.
- May contain sharp edges or points that can cause injury. Handle with care.
- Disassembled for delivery, check all parts for damage before assembly.
- Risk of suffocation due to loose or improperly fastened parts.
- Do not overload the bank to avoid structural damage.
