Safety Instructions:

- Ensure stability and correct installation of the belt locking post to prevent it from falling over.
- Mount the base plate correctly to prevent the post from tipping over.
- Make sure that the post, both indoors and outdoors, is stable and on a level, load-bearing surface.
- Avoid use in areas with extreme weather conditions, as this can impair stability.
- Observe the total weight of the post to ensure safe use in the intended environment.
- The belt must not be pulled out beyond the maximum extension length of 3 metres in order to avoid injury.
- Ensure that the centrifugal brake is working properly to ensure safe retraction of the belt and prevent uncontrolled retraction.
- The belt post is not a toy; therefore place it away from children to avoid the risk of suffocation and tripping.
- The belt must not be overloaded - observe the maximum loads!
- Warning: Do not lay the belt along potential tripping hazards.
- Carry out regular maintenance to check structural integrity, especially with frequent use.
- Follow the safety instructions in the installation instructions.
