Safety Instructions:

- Product not suitable for children under 3 years of age due to small parts that can be swallowed.
- Keep out of the reach of children to prevent small parts from being swallowed.
- This product should be kept out of the reach of children as it may be attractive to them due to its shape and texture.
- Avoid direct sunlight to prevent colour changes.
- Protect from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Use at extreme temperatures below -20°C and above 120°C can impair the material integrity.
- Stability may be impaired at temperatures above +120°C.
- Avoid direct contact of the product with fire or extreme temperatures above +120° C.
- Do not use or store near fire, as the material may melt at high temperatures.
- Avoid direct contact with fire or high temperatures.
- The product is waterproof, but make sure that it is not permanently submerged in water.
- Please note that the product is water and tear resistant, but does not exclude mechanical damage.
