Safety Instructions:

- The product is made of sheet steel and may have sharp edges. Pay attention to sharp edges and corners during assembly to avoid injury.
- Make sure that the material cabinet is stable when in use to prevent it from tipping over. Ensure that the cabinet is standing on a stable and level surface.
- During installation and use, ensure that the doors close properly and cannot be blocked in order to avoid crushing. Use suitable aids when closing the doors.
- The cabinet is suitable for indoor use. Keep the cabinet away from sources of water to prevent corrosion of the sheet steel. Moisture can damage the coating. The product should not be used in damp or extreme environments.
- Suitable tools are required for installation. Have the installation instructions to hand and ensure that all parts are installed correctly. Follow the instructions for installation and use to avoid injury and damage.
- Take care not to overload heavy objects to avoid overloading the doors. Avoid storing heavy objects on the top shelves to minimise stability risks.
- Always use the shoot bolt lock to prevent unauthorised opening.
- The product is not suitable for children under 3 years of age - choking hazard due to small parts.
- When the cabinet is installed, ensure that there is sufficient space for the door opening.
- Ensure that the product is used safely, especially during installation and use. Ensure that the product is used in accordance with the intended instructions.
- Regularly check the housing for damage and correct functioning of the locks.
- Do not use the cabinet for purposes for which it is not intended, e.g. not as a ladder or for storing hazardous materials.
- Read the operating instructions carefully and observe the recommended safety measures.
