Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the plan cabinet is placed on a stable, level surface to prevent it from toppling over.
- The maximum load per drawer is 40 kg. Take care not to exceed this and to distribute the weight evenly.
- Drawers are fully extendable. Use pull-out stops to prevent several drawers from being pulled out accidentally and be careful when using them to avoid jamming.
- Use a central locking system with keys to prevent unauthorised access.
- Ergonomic handles must be used to prevent injuries when opening.
- Take care not to trap any body parts when closing the drawers.
- Avoid aggressive cleaning agents and contact with water in order to protect the surfaces of the plan enclosure from damage and corrosion.
- Keep the area around the plan cabinet clear to avoid tripping hazards and to ensure that children do not have unsupervised access.
- Use plastic glides to avoid scratches and other damage to the floor.
- Ensure that the plan cabinet is not overloaded and only use it in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- At least 2 people should be required to move the filled drawers.
- The product is intended for indoor use, avoid outdoor use.
- Regular inspection of the drawer mechanisms and the stability of the steel structure is required.
- Be aware of the risk of serious injury or damage if the drawers are handled incorrectly or overloaded.
