Safety Instructions:

- Avoid falling or injury due to improper assembly. Follow the instructions for correct assembly in accordance with the instructions.
- Make sure that all parts are firmly screwed together and correctly inserted to ensure stability and safety. Only assemble the bench in accordance with the instructions.
- The bench is not suitable for children - choking hazard due to small parts. Children should only use the bench under adult supervision.
- To avoid injuries when sitting or standing up, ensure that the bench is stable and not overloaded. Observe the maximum load capacity.
- When using on slippery floors: Use a mat or non-slip feet to avoid the risk of falling.
- Constant checking for loose parts, stability and sharp edges is recommended to avoid accidents.
- Not suitable for outdoor use, only for indoor use. The bench should be protected from moisture.
- Avoid risk of injury due to improper use: Do not use the bench as a ladder or for other unintended purposes.
- Feet with height-adjustable glides must be ensured to prevent tipping. The adjustment mechanisms must be checked regularly.
- Maintain a safe distance from other furniture. Make sure that the bench is not placed in places where it could tip over.
- Avoid using force to prevent structural damage and tipping over. Observe the weight limit: The bench can bear a maximum load of 200 kg.
- Regular inspection of the connections and stability is recommended to avoid breakages.
- The use of shoe grids is recommended to protect the floor covering.
