Safety Instructions:

- The changing bench must be placed on a firm, stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Supplied disassembled - assemble carefully before use and ensure that all parts are present and correctly fitted.
- Assembly instructions and safety information must be observed and supplied with the product to ensure safe use.
- Height-adjustable glides must be correctly adjusted to prevent wobbling.
- The bench is only suitable for indoor use and must not be used outdoors.
- Check for damage before use; do not use if damaged and regularly check the seat for stability and safety.
- Caution: Risk of falling due to improper use or overloading; do not use the bench as a ladder or climbing aid.
- Not suitable for children under 12 years of age without supervision. Please note that the bench could potentially be used as a climbing structure, especially for children under the age of 3.
- Avoid overloading: Do not exceed the maximum load and do not place excessive weight on one side.
- Child safety: Keep small parts away from the Reach for children to avoid the risk of choking.
- Clean the bench regularly to ensure its longevity and safety.
- Ensure sufficient space and good lighting during installation; use stable and correct tools to avoid injuries.
- The stability of the bench must be checked regularly, especially after assembly.
- Stable construction: Follow the assembly instructions for safe use and ensure that the height-adjustable feet are set as required.
- Before assembly, ensure that all parts are present and observe the wood treatment to prevent damage caused by moisture.
- Risk of falling due to abrupt movements: Avoid such movements to prevent tipping over.
- Keep children under supervision when using the product to avoid injury.
