Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the workbench is placed on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- When lifting or moving the workbench, at least two people should be involved or suitable lifting techniques should be used to avoid injury.
- Do not exceed the maximum surface load of 1250 kg to avoid structural damage or injury.
- Take protective measures to avoid injury from sharp edges; personal protective equipment is recommended.
- Regularly check the workbench for stability, strength and loose parts, especially with frequent use.
- Users should wear suitable work shoes and check that the anti-slip studs are in good working order to avoid the risk of slipping.
- Securely and firmly lock the height-adjustable feet to prevent the workbench from tipping; ensure that the workbench is correctly adjusted.
- The workbench is not intended for use by children or as play equipment; keep children away.
- Avoid contact of water or other liquids with the wooden worktop to prevent mould growth and damage.
- Only use the workbench for its intended purpose and have it operated by trained personnel to avoid improper use.
- Ensure careful assembly; assemble all parts correctly to avoid risk of injury or suffocation.
