### Safety Instructions:

- Observe the maximum surface load of 450 kg to avoid overloading and the associated risk of injury.
- Always secure the mobile workbench with brakes on the castors to prevent it from rolling away unintentionally.
- Ensure that the workbench is placed on a stable and level surface to prevent tipping and accidents.
- Check the worktop for cracks or damage before use to minimise safety risks.
- Use only for its intended purpose to avoid injury or damage.
- Wear suitable personal protective equipment (PPE) such as gloves and safety goggles when working with tools.
- Pay attention to children and vulnerable persons in the vicinity of the workbench to ensure their safety.
- If the castors or other parts are damaged, stop using the workbench immediately to avoid accidents.
- Risk of suffocation due to improper handling of the castors if the product is not properly secured.
- Risk of injury from heavy lifting or improper use of the workbench, especially if the load exceeds 450 kg.
- Risk of collision due to the mobility of the workbench, especially in busy work areas.
- Sharp edges of metal parts can cause injuries.
- Do not place excessive loads on the worktop or shelf to avoid tipping over.
- To avoid injury, do not leave the workbench inaccessible to children.
